- Heritage Village is all a-buzz this weekend. In addition to Farm-City Week Celebration, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., the Pinellas County Market in the Park will have extended hours and stay open until 4 p.m., too. See farm animals, learn about agriculture and enjoy the unique items for sale at the market – all while enjoying the ambiance of Heritage Village. The village is located at 11909 125th St. N., Largo, and there will be additional parking available in the Culture, Education and Leisure parking lot by Florida Botanical Gardens.
- The weather is so beautiful this time of year. Guided hikes are ready to take you on adventures at three county parks and preserves. John Chesnut Park, from 9 to 10:30 a.m., features plants naturally found in wetlands and pine flatwoods. On the hike at Brooker Creek Preserve, from 9 to 11 a.m., see how the land has changed over time and discuss ecological footprints.
