- **Pop Into History I:** Visit the parlor for community life fun at the Plant-Sumner Home, take a journey on the “Sharpie” boat, load citrus at the Sulphur Springs Train Depot and build a cattle pen near the Union Academy.

- **Pop Into History II:** Visit the McMullen-Coachman Log Cabin for laundry chores, build an exhibit at the Lowe House, knot up some fun at the Lowe Barn and tend the garden at the Moore Grove House.
Start time: 10:30 a.m.
- **School for a Day:** Students attend class in a 1940s classroom with historical furnishings for a fun-filled day of lessons planned by their teacher.
