

**PINELLAS COUNTY FY 2011/12 – 2015/16
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) PROPOSED AMENDMENTS
ROLL FORWARD PROJECTS**

The following TIP amendments are roll forward projects that were not obligated prior to June 30, 2011, so the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)/Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funding was moved from FY 2011/12 to FY 2012/13 in the Florida Department of Transportation Work Program. These amendments will reconcile year one of the TIP with year one of the Work Program and are necessary to receive federal authorization for these projects.

- **FPN# 415769-1, St. Petersburg/Clearwater International Airport Improvements** - Adds \$484,250 in FY 2012 for aviation safety improvements. The primary funding source for this project is an airport improvements fund by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).
- **FPN# 421625-1, Pinellas County Jobs Access Reverse Commute (JARC) Program** - Adds \$1,488,415 in FY 2012 for the Pinellas County's Jobs Access Reverse Commute (JARC) program. The JARC Program is intended to allow for the development and maintenance of transportation services designed to transport welfare recipients and eligible low-income individuals to and from jobs and activities related to their employment. The funding source for this project is section 5316 federal earmark by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
- **FPN# 421626-1, Pinellas County New Freedom (NF) Program** - Adds \$1,564,628 in FY 2012 for Pinellas County's New Freedom (NF) program and is necessary to receive federal authorization for funding. The New Freedom (NF) program is designed to provide services and public transportation alternatives for disabled individuals beyond those required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. The funding source for this project is section 5317 federal earmark by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
- **FPN# 426474-1, St. Petersburg Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)** - Adds \$475,000 in FY 2012 for the City of St. Petersburg's Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit program. The funding source for this project is a Section 5309/Urban Corridor Improvements fund by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
- **FPN# 426474-2, St. Petersburg Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)** - Adds \$500,000 in FY 2012 for the City of St. Petersburg's Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit program. The funding source for this project is a Section 5309/Urban Corridor Improvements fund by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
