



Student Yield Factor ...

Student Yield Factor = 0.32 (total) public school students generated per each residential unit in Pinellas County.

For the purposes of calculating the number of **Elementary, Middle and High School** students generated by a proposed Future Land Use Map amendment, the Factor of 0.32 is broken down as follows:

0.15 Elementary Students per residential unit

0.07 Middle Students per residential unit

0.10 High School Students per residential unit

Example: A developer proposing a site plan with **100 residential units** would generate a **total** of 32 Students ($100 \times 0.32 = 32$ students), or 15 Elementary Students ($100 \times 0.15 = 15$); 7 Middle School Students ($100 \times 0.07 = 7$) and 10 High School Students ($100 \times 0.10 = 10$).
