

US HIGHWAY 19 NORTH CORRIDOR STUDY

The Pinellas County Planning Department is conducting economic, demographic and market analyses in the US 19 corridor in the vicinity of Curlew Road to just north of East Klosterman Road. This study will inform the need for potential future action plans to address transportation, land use, economic, and community-identified opportunities in this portion of unincorporated Pinellas County.

In a related effort, Forward Pinellas is embarking on a visioning study for the entire US 19 corridor in Pinellas County. The Planning Department and Forward Pinellas will coordinate efforts to engage the public and establish compatible land use and transportation goals and objectives to guide future improvement strategies.

- What are the trending future demographic, employment and market conditions in and near the Corridor?
- What kind of future land use, zoning, and urban design changes are necessary to improve the vitality of US Highway 19 for current and future residents and visitors?
