Pinellas County (County) is hosting a neighborhood meeting on Thursday, June 28, 2018 to provide information regarding the planned roadway improvements along Forest Lakes Boulevard (CR 667) from west of Pine Avenue to west of Race Track Road. The limits of the project fall within the City of Oldsmar. County representatives will be available at this meeting to review the proposed improvements and answer questions. The project primarily focuses on reconstructing and widening of the roadway from a two-lane to a four-lane divided suburban roadway. This will include modifications to the drainage system including the construction of underdrains and new drainage pipes to improve drainage conditions. In addition, the project will include upgrading the existing signalized intersections at Pine Avenue and Brooker Creek Boulevard. The widened roadway will provide a five-foot wide paved shoulder designated as a bike lane along with five-foot wide sidewalks on both sides of the road.

Existing traffic patterns will be maintained during construction by shifting traffic to an undivided condition on the north side while construction is underway on the south side and vice-versa for the north side construction. Intersection construction will require detours for one direction only and intermittent night-time only lane closures will be utilized throughout construction.
