Aluminum Cans

clean, empty aluminum cans such as soda or juice cans

1. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#).
2. **Recycle** at an event, such as a festival or block party (see [Event Recycling](#)).
3. **Sell** to a metal recycler:

5. **Business** options:
 - a) Sell cans to a metal recycler (see #2 above).
 - b) Take cans to a [recycling drop-off site](#).
 - c) Request on-site recycling service. See [ABC List](#) of on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including aluminum cans.
 - d) Recycle cans at an [event](#).
