### Antifreeze

*ethylene or propylene glycol coolant used in vehicle radiators*



**This is hazardous waste. Do NOT dispose with regular trash! Never leave a puddle of antifreeze on the driveway, or leave a bucket of antifreeze unattended. It can be fatal to children or pets.**

1. **Drop off** at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or the [HEC<sub>3</sub> facility](#) for recycling (free for residents):
  - a) The container cannot exceed 5 gallons in size.
  - b) If you are bringing more than 5 gallons total, call first (464-7500).
2. **Drop off** at a service station, auto parts store, or car dealer for free recycling:
  - a) Check to see if your local facility recycles antifreeze.
  - b) View a [listing](#) of EnviroPartner businesses that accept antifreeze for free.
3. *Safety Harbor residents:* **Drop off** at Safety Harbor Public Works, 1200 Railroad Ave., 724-1550 (free for residents).
4. **Business options:**
  - a) See options listed above.
  - b) **Drop off** antifreeze (for a [fee](#)) at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or an [EnviroBusiness Day](#) event at the HEC<sub>3</sub> facility.
  - c) **Contact** a [Chemical Recycling and Disposal Company](#) for local pickup.
