Building / Demolition Materials

flooring, doors, electrical fixtures, plumbing, lumber, lighting fixtures, windows, roofing materials, gutters, gypsum board, HVAC/AC units, tools, or carpeting

1. **Sell or donate:**

- a) See list of [local building material recyclers](#).
- b) Use [Freecycle](#). Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg).
- c) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#) or [Craigslist For Sale](#).

2. **Demolition procedures:**

- a) Earn points toward Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification by recycling materials instead of disposing them. For more information, visit [U.S. Green Building Council](#).
- b) For information on salvaging building materials, including [A Guide to Deconstruction](#), visit [Deconstruction Institute](#).
- c) If the building is to be replaced, contact the manufacturer of new materials being purchased to ask if they accept old materials for recycling.

3. **Dispose at [Solid Waste Operations](#)** (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles).
