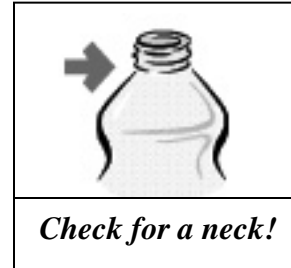

Plastic Bottles

empty plastic bottles that contained liquids such as soda or soap

1. **Reuse** plastic bottles for storage, bird feeders, funnels, etc.
2. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#):
 - a) In the past, you had to search for a code number #1 or #2. Now you don't need to worry about numbers. **If it's a plastic bottle, recycle it!**
 - b) If you're not sure it's a bottle, "**check for a neck**". You can recycle any plastic container with a neck (an opening smaller than the base).
 - c) Examples of plastic bottles you CAN recycle include: water, soda, milk, juice, ketchup, mouthwash, liquid household cleaners, shampoo, salad dressing, laundry detergent, and syrup bottles.
 - d) Only plastic *bottles* please—NO plastic tubs (such as margarine), cups (such as yogurt), trays, 6-pack rings, or bags.
 - e) Please rinse bottle. Remove and throw away caps or pumps. Labels are okay.
3. **Recycle** at an event, such as a festival or block party (see [Event Recycling](#)).
4. **Schools** interested in collecting plastic bottles can contact [Keep Pinellas Beautiful](#) (533-0402) to request free bins and collection.
5. **Business** options:
 - a) Take bottles to a [recycling drop-off site](#).
 - b) Request on-site recycling service. See [ABC List](#) of on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including plastic bottles.
 - c) Recycle bottles at an [event](#).
