Explosives

This is hazardous waste. Do NOT dispose with regular trash!

1. In an **emergency situation**, call 911.
2. In a **non-emergency situation**, call the police to arrange pickup of a potentially explosive item such as a World War II grenade or can of ether. Don't touch the item—call the police!
 - a) Call the Pinellas County Sheriff's Dept. at 582-6200 if you live in an unincorporated area or a city that does not have its own police department.
 - b) Call your city's police department if they have one (see below):
