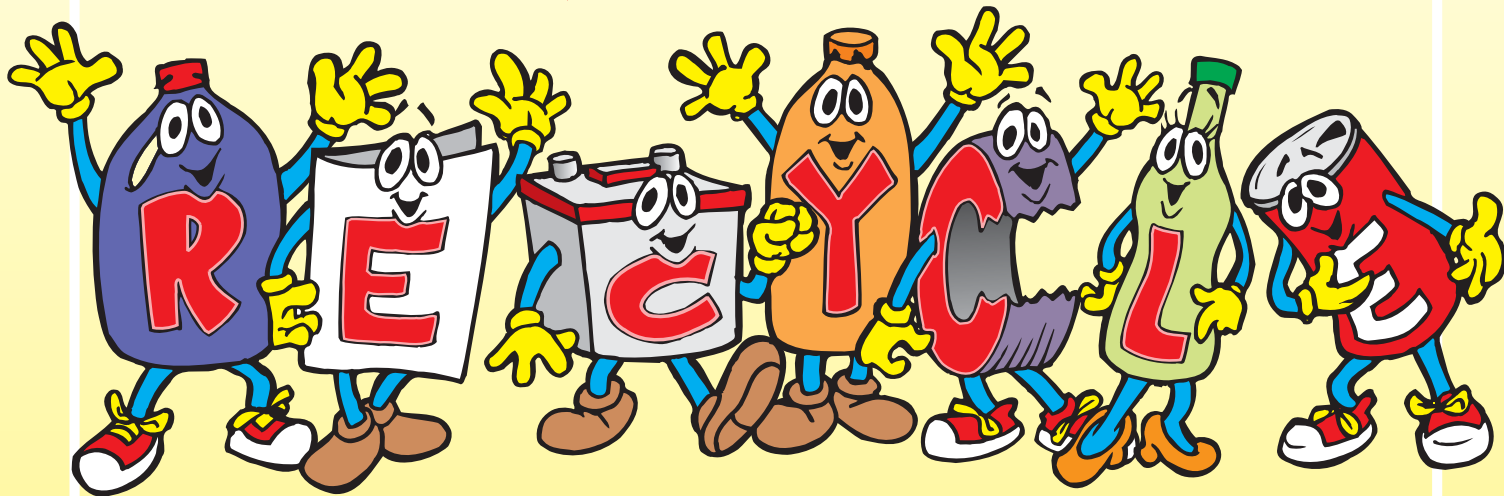

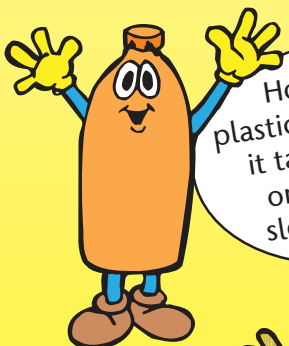
What are the "3Rs" for trash?

I will **write on both sides** of my paper.



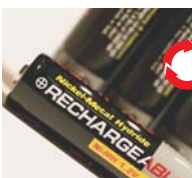
I will **buy recycled products** (such as notebook paper).



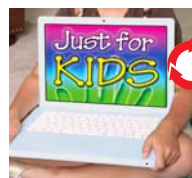
I will try to **fix broken items** instead of buying a new one.

ANSWERS



▶ The 3Rs mean to **REDUCE**, **REUSE**, and **RECYCLE** as much of our trash as possible, instead of throwing everything away!



▶ It takes 35 plastic 2-liter bottles to make one recycled sleeping bag.



▶ Reuse a cardboard box to keep things in, mail something, or make a craft project.



▶ Aluminum cans are recycled into license plates, pie plates, foil, or new beverage cans.



▶ Some recycled items you can buy for school are paper, folders, envelopes, and index cards. Look on the label for a recycle logo.



▶ The 3 arrows in the recycle logo stand for: collect, process, and buy. “Close the recycling loop” means to buy a recycled product.
