### Aluminum Cans

*clean, empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food such as soda cans*

1. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#).
2. **Recycle** at an event, such as a festival or block party (see [Event Recycling](#)).
3. **Sell** to a metal recycler. Please call first to ask about minimum requirements.

4. **Drop off** at a local school for recycling. Many schools raise money by collecting cans. View a listing of [schools participating in "Project Can Do"](#).
5. **Drop off** at a local [Target store](#) for recycling (bins located inside the store near the registers).
6. **Fundraising:** Schools or non-profit organizations can raise money by contacting [Best Metal Recycling](#) (524-2550 or [e-mail](#)) to request a free bin for aluminum.
7. **Business options:**
  - a) **Sell** cans to a metal recycler (see #3 above).
  - b) **Recycle** cans at a municipal drop-off site. See [Recycling Map](#), and click on a map number for a list of items accepted.
  - c) **Request** on-site recycling service. See [ABC List](#) of on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including aluminum cans.
  - d) **Recycle** cans at an [event](#).
