Boats

1. Sell:

- a) to a boater or boat dealer
- b) yard sale
- c) Internet
- d) [Craigslist For Sale](#)—Select “post” to list your boat.
- e) Free newspaper ad in the [St. Petersburg Times](#) (3-line limit). Free ads are available for non-motorized boats such as kayaks, canoes, sail boats, and boat accessories, but not for boats with a motor.

2. Sell metal boats to a metal recycler.

- a) Title is required.
- b) Call first to ask about requirements for removing non-metal components.
- c) Pickup is usually not provided.

3. Donate:

- a) Call a [charity that accepts vehicles](#) (provides free pickup and an IRS tax-deductible donation receipt). Title and trailer are required.
- b) Use [Freecycle](#). Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg), and list your boat.
- c) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to list your boat.
- d) Free newspaper ads—[St. Petersburg Times](#) (3 lines) or [Tampa Bay Newspapers](#) (15 words). Free St. Petersburg Times ads are available for non-motorized boats such as kayaks, canoes, sail boats, and boat accessories, but not for boats with a motor.

Boats continued

4. **Drop off** at [Angelo's Recycled Materials](#) (1755 20th Ave., SE, Largo, 581-1544) for a recycling fee of \$10 per linear foot.
 - a) Title is required.
 - b) Boat must be stripped of motor, battery, gas tank, float switch and all electronics.

5. **Request pickup** for recycling or disposal. Some haulers have the capability to handle small boats.
 - a) Residents living in municipalities, see [Bulk Item Disposal by Municipality](#) for contact information
 - b) Residents not living in municipalities, see [Bulk Item Disposal for Unincorporated Areas](#) for a list of haulers.

6. **Dispose** at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles):
 - a) Boat cannot exceed 24 ft. in length.
 - b) Fiberglass and wood hulls are accepted.
 - c) Boat must be stripped of motor, battery, gas tank, float switch and all electronics. Please check for hidden fuel tanks such as under the deck.
 - d) If a boat is loaded with trash or debris, it will need to be emptied so that it may be inspected before disposal.
 - e) Patron must be able to unload the boat; landfill contractor will not assist. Patron may not attach a rope or chain to any County property in order to remove the boat from the transport vehicle.
 - f) Trailer tires must be removed if also disposing of trailer (see [Trailers](#)).
