### Cardboard

*clean, empty, flattened corrugated cardboard boxes*

*(TIP: corrugated cardboard has three layers including a wavy middle layer)*

1. **Reuse** your old boxes for storage, mailing, crafts, or children's games.
2. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#).
3. **Drop off** cardboard:
  - a) [Louise Graham Regeneration Center](#), 2301 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. S., St. Petersburg (327-9444) - offers training and services for developmentally disabled adults.
  - b) Recycling Services of Florida, 3560 - 126<sup>th</sup> Ave. N., Clearwater (573-9150)
  - c) [SP Recycling Corporation](#), 8810 Enterprise Blvd., Largo (507-0777)
4. **Businesses** have several recycling options:
  - a) Take cardboard to a private drop-off site (see #3 above) or a [municipal drop-off site](#).
  - b) Request on-site recycling service. The companies listed below collect cardboard or paper products only. See [ABC List](#) for on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including cardboard.
