## Floppy Disks

*diskette used to store computer data*

\* Floppy disks are not hazardous and may be placed in the regular garbage.

1. **Reuse** for craft projects such as a pen holder (see [Planet Green](#)).
2. **Recycle** using a mail-in program such as:
  - a) [Floppy Disk](#) (800) 397-7890 - Accepts floppy disks. Payment of two cents per disk is offered for quantities of 500 or more.
  - b) [CD Recycling Center](#) (603) 894-5553 - Accepts floppy disks, CDs, DVDs, Blu-rays, videotapes, cassette tapes and cases.
  - c) [Green Disk](#) (800) 305-3475 - Accepts floppy disks, CDs, DVDs, Blu-rays, videotapes, cassette tapes and electronic items.
  - d) [Alternative Community Training](#), (800) 359-4607 - Accepts floppy disks, CDs, DVDs, videotapes, cassette tapes, cases and small electronics.
3. **Contact** a [document shredding company](#). Most offer confidential shredding services for a variety of office items, including paper and disks.
