### Litter

*discarded refuse or trash*

1. Please **recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#) any recyclable litter that you pick up such as aluminum cans, plastic bottles, steel cans, etc.
  
2. **Contact** [Keep Pinellas Beautiful](#) (533-0402):
  - a) Report litter to the Litter Hotline by calling 210-GONE (4663).
  - b) Volunteer for a litter cleanup event, such as:
    - Great American Cleanup - March 19, 2011
    - Mid-Summer Coastal Cleanup - July 9, 2011
    - Pinellas Coastal Cleanup - October 15, 2011
    - Listed above are the largest annual events, but there are many other local events. Check the [Keep Pinellas Beautiful calendar](#) for dates and locations.
  - c) Volunteer for the [Pinellas Marine Litter Patrol Program](#) if you have a canoe or kayak.
  - d) Volunteer for a [litter cleanup adoption program](#), such as Adopt-a-Mile, Adopt-a-Shore, or Adopt-a-Highway.
