1. **Reuse** (swap):
 - a) Exchange with friends or family.
 - b) Exchange with co-workers. For example, you can set up a small bookcase in the break room.
 - c) Exchange with neighbors. You can set up a rack or bookcase in a “community room” at a mobile home park, apartment complex, senior community, etc.

2. **Donate**:
 - a) [library](#)

 - c) [senior center](#)
 - d) [Youth Arts Corps](#), 5180 62nd Ave. N., Pinellas Park (521-5308) for student art projects
 - e) [hospital](#) waiting room
 - f) retirement or nursing home

 - i) school: [public](#) or [private](#) (children’s magazines)
 - j) [preschool or child care center](#) (children’s magazines)

3. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#) with mixed paper. Please remove non-paper items such as plastic wrap or CDs.

4. **Drop off** at a [SP Recycling Corporation bin](#) for recycling (over 300 drop-off sites).
