Music

CDs, records (vinyl), cassettes

1. **Reuse:**

- a) Swap unwanted music with friends or family.
- b) Swap CDs online (for example: Swap.com or [SwapaCD](http://SwapaCD.com)). Trading is often free except for shipping costs.

2. **Sell or trade** CDs or vinyl records to a secondhand music store:

- c) Use [Freecycle](#)—Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, Largo, North Pinellas, or St. Petersburg), and list your items.
- d) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to list your items.

5. **Drop off** CDs or cases at a Best Buy store for recycling (DVDs also accepted). Look for a recycling kiosk inside the store entrance.

6. **Recycle** using a mail-in program such as:
 - a) [CD Recycling Center](#) (603) 894-5553 - Accepts CDs, cassette tapes, cases DVDs, floppy disks, Blu-rays, and videotapes.
 - b) [Green Disk](#) (800) 305-3475 - Accepts CDs, cassette tapes, DVDs, Blu-rays, videotapes, floppy disks, and electronic items.
 - c) [Alternative Community Training](#), (800) 359-4607 - Accepts CDs, cassette tapes, cases, floppy disks, DVDs, videotapes, and small electronics.
