Newspapers

1. **Reuse:**
 - a) Share with a friend, neighbor, or co-worker
 - b) Use for packing material (shipping or storage)
 - c) Donate to a [shelter](#) to line animal cages.

2. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#).

3. **Drop off** at a [SP Recycling bin](#):
 - a) There are over 250 SP Recycling bins throughout Pinellas County at schools, churches, mobile home parks, service clubs, etc.
 - b) Schools or non-profit organizations interested in collecting newspaper as a fundraiser can contact [SP Recycling](#) (507-0777) to request a free bin.

4. **Businesses** have several recycling options:
 - a) Donate to an animal shelter (see #1 above).
 - b) Drop off at a SP Recycling bin (see #3 above) or a [municipal drop-off site](#).
 - c) Request on-site recycling service. The companies listed below collect paper products only. See [ABC List](#) for on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including paper.
