Phone Books

telephone directories

(Please remove plastic wrap, bag, or magnets before recycling.)

1. **Reduce** waste by not using a printed phone book if you don't need one:
 - a) Use online listings such as www.superpages.com or www.yellowpages.com or free directory assistance (1-800-FREE-411) instead of a phone book.
 - b) Opt out (cancel) delivery of phone books or request fewer copies. It is no longer necessary to contact phone book publishers individually. Simply register online at the [Yellow Pages Association](http://www.yellowpages.com) to indicate which phone books you want delivered at home or at work. NOTE: You must register first before you can opt out. If possible, contact them 90 days before the scheduled delivery date:
 - Verizon (SuperMedia) delivery: June - July
 - Yellow Book delivery: Nov. - Dec.

2. **Recycle:**
 - a) compost bin (tear into pieces first for best results)
 - b) [curbside or drop-off recycling options](#) (including 11 curbside programs, 42 municipal drop-off sites, and over 300 private drop-off sites)

3. **Business** options:
 - a) **Reduce** the number of phone books delivered (see #1 above).
 - b) **Recycle** at a [drop-off site](#).
 - c) **Request** on-site recycling service for paper items, including phone books (see [Paper](#)).
