4. Donate:

- a) [Local thrift store or charity](#) Call first since some do not accept large items such as pianos or organs.
- b) Check with a local [senior center](#), nursing home, or assisted living facility.
- c) Use [Freecycle](#)—Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg), and list your item.
- d) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to list your item.
- e) Free newspaper ads—[St. Petersburg Times](#) (3 lines) or [Tampa Bay Newspapers](#) (15 words)
