3. **Donate** toys (usable or broken) to [Christmas Toy Shop](#), 550 - 16th St., N., St. Petersburg (898-3962 or [e-mail](#)). Hours of operation for Toy Shop donations are Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday from 9am to 3pm only.
 - a) Toys will be repaired if necessary.
 - b) Toys (and bicycles) are donated to needy families every December.
 - c) Pickup may be available.
 - d) No stuffed animals, knives, or guns please.

4. **Donate** usable toys:

 - b) [recreation center](#)
 - c) [preschool or child care center](#)
 - d) Use [Freecycle](#)—Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg), and list your toys.
 - e) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to list your toys.
 - f) Free newspaper ads—[St. Petersburg Times](#) (3 lines) or [Tampa Bay Newspapers](#) (15 words).
