Bruce,

As I mentioned yesterday, there are additional issues that the Largo City Commission raised in its responding resolution to be discussed during the ISBA negotiations. I would like to have them put on the agenda for discussion at the next ISBA session. Since you are chairing that meeting, I would appreciate it if you would include these on the agenda. The additional issues are:

1. The ability of a municipality to annex any County-owned land, including roads and ROWs, contained within the city's municipal service area without being required to obtain consent from Pinellas County. Alternatively, if you municipal service area is agreed to, the process and criteria for annexing county-owned land, including but not limited to roads and ROWs.
2. Identification of local government responsible for delivery or funding of services within a municipal service area or unincorporated service area pursuant to Section 171.203(6), including road ownership, construction and maintenance, including but not limited to the transfer of responsibility for maintenance of ROW upon annexation of adjacent properties, the clarification of and transfer of ROW and maintenance responsibility for county roadways within the city, including the County's responsibility to make improvements prior to transfer of responsibility, and the design for county roadway projects within the City: and stormwater management.
3. Revocation of any existing interlocal agreements governing annexation between the City of Largo and other governmental entities, including but not limited to the interlocal agreement between the City, Pinellas Park and Pinellas County.
