

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING REVISED RETAIL SEWER
RATES FOR PINELLAS COUNTY SEWER SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Pinellas County Sewer System provides sewer service to customers within its sewer service area, as designated by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, at retail rates; and

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter of Pinellas County and the Florida Statutes authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, to revise sewer rates when necessary, by resolution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such authority, the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, has considered the increased costs associated with the current and future renovations, construction, and improvements to the sewer systems, reduced flows, and debt service; and

WHEREAS, notice was provided through the billing process as required in Section 180.136, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on the 28th day of September, 2010, with due and proper notice given on this Resolution adopting the revised retail sewer rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, in regular meeting duly assembled this 28th day of September, 2010, that said revised Retail Sewer Rates are adopted as follows:

Effective for billings on or after October 1, 2010:

- 1) Sewer Volumetric Rate \$ 3.84 per 1,000 gallons
- 2) Base Rate Charge \$10.50 per month

The Base Rate Charge is billed bi-monthly for each customer whether the service is on or off.
