RE: Proposed Pinellas County Precinct Lines

In compliance with Florida Statute 101.001, I am requesting your approval of the new precinct lines, which are shown on the enclosed county map. This item is on your May 22 Commission meeting agenda.

Once new congressional, state senate and house, county commission and school board district lines are approved, we must ensure that county precinct boundaries follow the new district lines. When the precinct lines are approved, we can move forward with other requirements that include updating the voter database with the new district and precinct lines and mailing new voter information cards to all 600,000 Pinellas County voters in June.

This is the first time any of my staff has been through this process, and I am extremely proud of the job they did. I would like to recognize Rick Becker, Julie Marcus, Marc Gillette and Nicole Foglio for going far beyond the requirements of this project in order to make additional changes that will better serve our voters for years to come.

Those changes include:

- Eliminating lines that divided neighborhoods
- Adjusting lines so voters are closer to their polling places
- Minimizing the number of polling place changes so our voters can continue voting at locations with which they are familiar

Our reprecincting efforts resulted in the following:

- Number of precincts reduced from 376 to 298
- Number of polling places reduced from 238 to 234
- 80% of our voters will vote at their current polling places
- 32% (122) of the precincts have no boundary changes

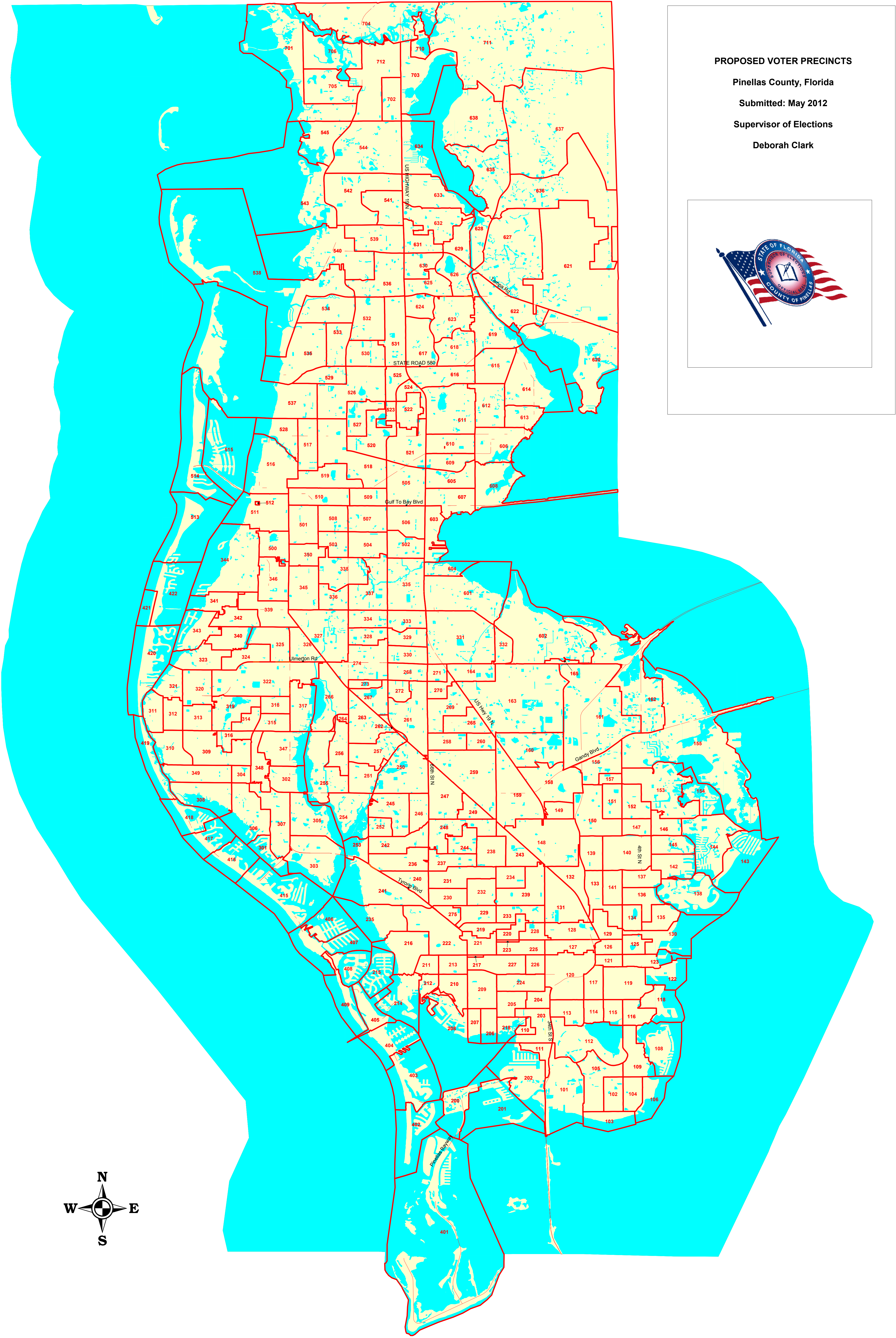
