FY13 Schedule of Fees for Non-Proprietary and Enterprise Departments effective October 1, 2012

**Recommended Action:**

I RECOMMEND THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ADOPT THE RESOLUTION SETTING USER FEES FOR SERVICES TO BE RENDERED BY NON-PROPRIETARY DEPARTMENTS, THE AIRPORT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE-UTILITIES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 2013.

**Summary Explanation/Background:**

As part of the development of the FY13 Proposed Budget, departments were asked to review their fees for opportunities to enhance revenue recovery from specific benefiting parties and relieve pressure on property taxes. Departments were challenged to recover both direct and indirect (i.e. overhead) costs as long as we remain competitive with other public/private service providers. The attached FY13 Fee Schedule is consistent with information provided during the Proposed FY13 Budget presented to the Board on July 10, 2012 with two exceptions. The Emergency Medical Services (EMS) fees for Sunstar Transports and Services items were added subsequent to the publication of the fee schedule in the Proposed Budget. These fees have been historically adopted with a separate resolution. Incorporating the EMS fees within this resolution captures all non-proprietary fees in one resolution enhancing transparency. The fee reduction for a tankless gas water heater permit was added by the Building and Development Review Services Department. Both additions do not change the estimated fee revenue amounts for the General Fund.

Fee changes, including new fees, proposed in FY13 are estimated to generate an additional \$52,810 in General Fund revenue. Of this total, the new fees associated with the park road closure fee and the toll surcharge fee result in an increase of \$42,730 in revenues. The purpose of the park road closure fee is to mitigate the impact of loss revenue from visitors that chose to avoid the park due to a special event hosted by "For Profit" organizations. The toll surcharge fee will depend on the County negotiating with the State to collect tolls that would recover the County's cost related to overnight campers.

Fee changes are estimated to generate an additional \$510,501 in revenue for Other Funds excluding the Health Department. The Sunstar Transports and Services changes are estimated to generate an additional \$444,383 in revenue for the Emergency Medical Services Fund. This increased revenue is based on the application of the Medical Consumer Price Index, which reflects a 3.95% increase. These fees are set in accordance with Section 54-64 of the Pinellas County Code and the rates are adjusted accordingly. These are existing fees that are now being reflected in the annual user fee schedule.

The Building and Development Review Services Department revised their fees and charges in the Proposed Budget for clarity and cost recovery purposes this year. The impact to the revenue in FY13 is minimal except the new fee for biennial update of Permit Plus Contractor information, which results in an additional \$45,000 to the

Fund. The Department of Environment and Infrastructure – Solid Waste added new fees in the Proposed Budget to pass through the cost of the radio frequency transponders to participants who request the device for usage of the automated lanes at the solid waste facility.

The attached fee schedule also does not include wholesale and retail sewer and water rates nor reclaimed water rates as they are adopted separately.

**Fiscal Impact/Cost/Revenue Summary:**

The proposed fee changes in FY13 are estimated to generate an additional \$52,810 in General Fund revenue. The total anticipated General Fund revenue for FY13 from non-proprietary user fees is approximately \$9.0 million.

The proposed fee changes in FY13 are estimated to generate an additional \$510,501 in revenue for Other Funds excluding the Health Department. The Health Department clinical services fee changes result in a revenue increase of \$126,570.

**RESOLUTION NO. 12 - \_\_\_\_\_**

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR NON-PROPRIETARY DEPARTMENTS, THE AIRPORT AND DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE-UTILITIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida is empowered to set fees relating to the provision of services provided by Non-Proprietary Departments, the Airport, and the Department of Environment and Infrastructure-Utilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, through Chapter 14, Section 14-47, of the Pinellas County Code, is authorized to establish reasonable fees and charges related to licensing, adoption, impoundment, service fees and such other fees for animals as deemed necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is empowered by Chapter 26164, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1949, as amended by Chapter 57-1730, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1957, to fix and prescribe permit and inspection fees for building, electrical and other permits as deemed necessary; and


