NOTICE: THIS IS TO ADVISE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THAT THE ABOVE-REFERENCED LAWSUIT WAS FILED AGAINST THE COUNTY AND THE COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE WILL DEFEND THE SAME.

DISCUSSION: Plaintiff, Beaver Gamble was involuntarily resigned from employment with Pinellas County as a result of a Personnel Board determination on or about June 5, 2008, that Mr. Gamble be resigned in lieu of termination. Subsequently, Mr. Gamble has periodically filed lawsuits against Pinellas County, or its various departments, stemming from his separation of employment. The prior actions have been summarily dismissed by the Court without necessity of action being taken on behalf of Pinellas County. In this case, however, Plaintiff sought, and received, a waiver of service of summons on behalf of the Defendants.

The County Attorney's office is defending appropriately.
