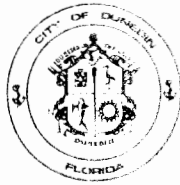

(or as soon thereafter as it may be heard) to hear comments for a request to annex property located at 1410 Main Street, 1402 Carnation Drive, vacant land immediately north of 1402 Carnation Drive and 1418 Carnation Drive (Parcel Nos. 26-28-15-00000-140-1000, 26-28-15-00000-140-1010, 26-28-15-00000-140-0900 and 26-28-15-00000-140-0800).

All persons are hereby advised that any presentation they make to the Dunedin City Commission will be encouraged to be as concise as possible and that the Commission may limit the time of each individual to permit maximum participation by the public at large.

A copy of the proposed ordinance, with complete legal description by metes and bounds or plat reference, is available to the public at the City Clerk's Office, 750 Milwaukee Avenue, during regular business hours. Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Dunedin City Commission with respect to any matter considered at this hearing will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based - per Florida Statute 286.0105.

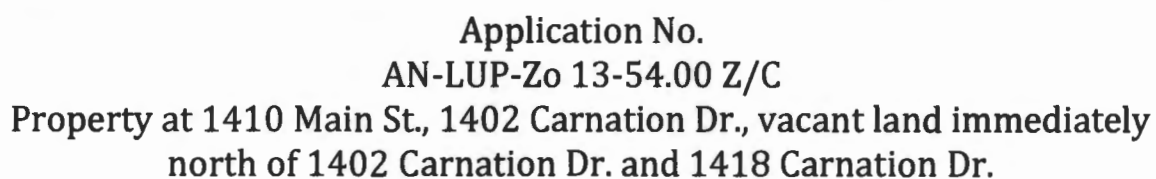
