Adoption of a Resolution Supplementing the FY13 General Fund for the Communities Putting Prevention to Work Grant, Pinellas County 4-H Foundation and Weedon Island and Brooker Creek Education Centers and Preserves – Parks and Conservation Resources.

Recommended Action:

I RECOMMEND THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (BOARD) ADOPT THE ATTACHED RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE UNANTICIPATED RECEIPTS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE IN THE FY13 GENERAL FUND.

Summary Explanation/Background:

Pinellas County was awarded the Communities Putting Prevention to Work (CPPW) Grant in 2012 and this grant went into effect on November 1, 2012, providing the County with an original amount of \$113,760 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. This resolution recognizes additional revenue for this grant in the amount of \$34,850. Grant funding was appropriated by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, through the Florida Department of Health to the Pinellas County Health Department. The Pinellas County Health Department is partnering with the Department of Parks and Conservation Resources to provide programs designed to make healthy choices easier by promoting environmental changes at the local level. This may be done via policy changes, improving access to physical activity, healthy foods and other healthy living choices. Pinellas County emphasizes reduction in obesity rates under their CPPW grant funding.

This resolution also appropriates \$32,810 in donations from the following Trust and Agency accounts. Donations of \$2,640 from the Pinellas County 4-H Foundation provides funding for one part-time contractual youth mentor who will update the 4-H website and train other volunteers to provide that function, coordinate the 4-H County and Teen Councils and create educational resources. This position is temporary and will end when the donated funding is exhausted. Weedon Island donations of \$3,470 and Brooker Creek donations of \$26,700 are appropriated for the maintenance, operation and improvement to the education centers and preserves at these locations.

Fiscal Impact/Cost/Revenue Summary:

Approval of this resolution recognizes unanticipated grant funds in the amount of \$34,850 in the General Fund and a transfer of \$32,810 from the Trust & Agency Account to the General Fund and increases the FY13 budget for Parks and Conservation Resources Department accordingly.
