I RECOMMEND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (BOARD) APPROVE THE RANKING OF FIRMS AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT FOR MULTI-FLIGHT INFORMATION AND DISPLAY SYSTEM (MUFIDS) AND VOICE PAGING SYSTEM (VPS) - AIRPORT WITH THE NUMBER ONE RANKED FIRM, INFAX, INC. (INFAX), DULUTH, GEORGIA.

Summary Explanation/Background:

On April 22, 2013, the Purchasing Department on behalf of the St Pete-Clearwater International Airport (Airport), released a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the purpose of seeking qualified consultants to provide a single entity solution that addresses all areas of a MUFIDS and VPS. The MUFIDS/VPS project will replace the current VPS which is over twenty years old, and is very costly to repair since it is beyond its lifespan. The current MUFIDS system is over ten years old and unable to accept visual paging inputs due to age and simplicity of the system. MUFIDS provides commercial carrier departure and arrival, baggage claim, passenger notices and weather information, as well as visual paging. The new digital VPS will be connected to existing speaker circuits and will provide features such as required A.D.A. visual paging, self diagnostics, distribution of pre-recorded and real time information, and the ability to auto-construct messages. Additionally, it will be equipped with IP microphone stations and may include an ambient noise monitoring system.

The Evaluation Committee (Committee) consisted of two representatives from the Airport, one representative from Business Technology Services and one representative from the Department of Environment and Infrastructure with the Purchasing Department facilitating the evaluation process. The Committee met on July 11, 2013 to review and evaluate the RFP responses, and rank the three proposals received. The evaluation process was two-step consisting of an evaluation of written responses where firms were short listed, followed by a demonstration by the short listed firms

Proposals were received from three (3) firms:

1. Infax, Inc
2. Signature Technologies Inc.
3. Altel Systems Group Inc. (not shortlisted)

The final ranking of firms is as follows:

1. Infax, Inc. – 892.05
2. Signature Technologies Inc. – 803.63

At the direction of the Board, staff will begin negotiations with the top ranked firm Infax. A final negotiated contract will be presented to the Board for consideration at a later date.

Fiscal Impact/Cost/Revenue Summary:

Estimated Total Expenditure: \$826,000.00

Funding for this project is provided through the Federal Aviation Administration's approved Airport Passenger Facility Charges (50%) and a Florida Department of Transportation grant (50%).
