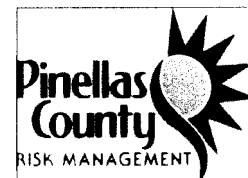
Attached is a memo dated July 8, 2014, that references one claim settlement for an alleged trip and fall in the amount of \$38,500.00.

This report describes the second quarter claim settlements of 2014 for amounts between \$25,001 and \$50,000. Only one claim settlement falls within this range.

Claim of Patricia Bonnett, Claim Number: 0900077

Ms. Bonnett allegedly tripped and fell on the uneven surface of a County owned and maintained sidewalk in the vicinity of 1802 Gulf Blvd, Indian Rocks Beach on April 7, 2009. The County contested the percentage of liability as well as the extent of damages claimed based upon her sole injury, a fractured knee cap. The claim went to litigation on September 20, 2010. The case settled on May 14, 2014 for \$38,500.
