Résumés and applications are now being accepted for three appointments on the Citizen Advisory Committee for the Southside St. Petersburg Community Redevelopment Area. Résumés must be received no later than the close of business on Monday, Jan. 5, 2015.

The committee advises the Community Redevelopment Agency for Southside St. Petersburg on the proposed community redevelopment plan and any proposed amendments to that plan, and on issues and policies within the Southside St. Petersburg Community Redevelopment Area.

The committee was created by an interlocal agreement between Pinellas County and the city of St. Petersburg to set up the framework for establishing and administering the Southside St. Petersburg Community Redevelopment Area.

The board has nine members. Three members are appointed by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners and six members are appointed by the mayor of St. Petersburg. Applicants must be residents, business and/or property owners or others stakeholders from within the Southside St. Petersburg Community Redevelopment Area. The board meets the first Tuesday of each month at 6 p.m. in Conference Room 100 of St. Petersburg City Hall at 175 Fifth St. N. in St. Petersburg.
