## **Vacancy for Pinellas County representative on the TBARTA Citizens Advisory Committee**

Applications are now being accepted for one appointment to the Tampa Bay Area Regional Transportation Authority (TBARTA) Citizens Advisory Committee. The appointment is for a two-year term, with an opportunity for reappointment thereafter. This is an unpaid and voluntary position. Members may not be transportation agency staff.

The Citizens Advisory Committee is made up of residents and business persons from around the region. Members are appointed by the TBARTA Board and volunteer their time to advise the Board on a range of issues that affect TBARTA and the region. The role of the Committee includes providing region-oriented advice to the Authority regarding the development and implementation of a transportation master plan, representing a wide range of stakeholder interests and community organizations, evaluating proposals and proposed solutions from a citizen's perspective, promoting public awareness and participating in the planning and implementation of the Master Plan and helping to disseminate information to local citizen groups.
