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Board vacancy on Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority

Applications are being accepted for a three-year citizen appointment to the Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority Board.

Each appointed member of the Board shall be a person who is a qualified elector of the county with an outstanding reputation for civic pride, interest, integrity, responsibility, and business ability. The citizen appointment may not be an elected official, nor may she/he be employed by any city or the county in any capacity.

Members may not have any private financial interest, directly or indirectly, in any contract, work, or business of the Authority or any public transit system subject to regulation by the Authority or be in the employ of or hold any stock, bond, investment, or other financial interest or private business relationship to any operator of a public transit system in the area.

Meetings of the Authority are held on a monthly basis, usually the fourth Wednesday. Board positions are unpaid, voluntary positions. This is a working board and the Authority is seeking members who can dedicate the time to attend monthly meetings on a consistent basis. The Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority Board consists of 15 members. Eight of the fifteen board members must be present in order to hold a meeting. All meetings are open to the public.
