## **Applicants sought for Parks and Conservation Resources Advisory Board and Feather Sound Community Services District**

Résumés are now being accepted for appointments to the Parks and Conservation Resources Advisory Board and Feather Sound Community Services District.

The Parks and Conservation Resources Advisory Board acts in an advisory capacity to the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners and the county administrator in their power to provide parks, preserves, historical commissions and other recreational and cultural programs. The term runs for one year and there is one vacancy.

The Feather Sound Community Services District, Inc is a non-profit corporation organized for the purpose of providing street lighting and the acquisition, development and maintenance of recreational areas and green space for the residents of Feather Sound. The FSCSD board is composed of seven volunteer members from the Feather Sound community, appointed by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners. The term runs for one year and there is one vacancy. Interested citizens must live within the bounds of the Feather Sound Community Services District and must be registered voters.
