**Applications now being accepted for Public Employee Relations Commission**

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners is now accepting applications for two appointments to the Public Employee Relations Commission. Each appointment term is four years.

The PERC is responsible for resolving collective bargaining questions by public employees as well as considering charges of unfair labor practices and violations of state statutes that prohibit strikes by public employees.

Meetings of the commission are held as needed.

Applicants must be registered to vote in Pinellas County. Commission members cannot be employed by or hold any commission with a governmental unit in the state or any employee organization, as defined in Article IV of the Pinellas County Code of Ordinances.

Upon reviewing all applications, the County Administrator will select the appointees and, with the concurrence of the constitutional officers, recommend them for approval by the Board of County Commissioners at the Nov. 24 Board meeting.
