## **Vacancy announced on Historic Preservation Board**

Applications are now being accepted for one alternate member on the Pinellas County Historic Preservation Board.

The Historic Preservation Board is comprised of seven members and two alternates, nominated by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners for a term of three years. The Historic Preservation Board is composed of community advocates, municipal representatives and historic preservation professionals with expertise and/or knowledge in the historic preservation field, archaeology, preservation architecture, history, preservation planning, etc. This is a volunteer position and members receive no compensation.

The county's historic preservation program operates as a Certified Local Government program, and meets the guidelines and criteria for this federal historic program designation with responsibilities including recommending the designation of historic districts and landmarks, nominating historic resources for listing on the National Register of Historic Plans, reviewing and approving applications for impacts to properties in a historic district or a landmark and landmark site, producing educational materials, programs and publications, etc.

Applications must be received no later than the close of business on Friday, April 8. The Board of County Commissioners will review all applications and make their selections at a future board meeting.
