Applications accepted for Public Employee Relations Commission

Interested individuals should submit an online application by July 1

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners is now accepting applications for an appointment to the Public Employee Relations Commission (PERC). The appointment term is four years. Meetings of the commission are held as needed.

The PERC is responsible for resolving collective bargaining questions by public employees as well as considering charges of unfair labor practices and violations of state statutes that prohibit strikes by public employees.

To qualify, applicants must be a person who, on account of previous vocation, employment, or affiliation, is, or has been, classified as a representative of employees, and cannot be employed by or hold any commission with a governmental unit in the state or any employee organization, as defined in Article IV of the Pinellas County Code of Ordinances.

Applications can be found online at www.pinellascounty.org/advisoryboards. All applications must be received no later than the close of business on Friday, July 1.

Upon reviewing all applications, the County Administrator will select the appointee and with the concurrence of the Constitutional Officers recommend them for approval by the Board of County Commissioners at a future Board meeting.
