

Inside Seminole




The campus is set back from the west side of 113th Street North, next to the Seminole Recreation Ctr. and behind Seminole Community Library @ SPC Seminole.

The driveway starts at the traffic lights, half way between 102nd Avenue (to the north) and Park Blvd. (to the south).

From North Pinellas County

- estimated time 25 min.
from Ulmerton and US 19

Go south on 66th Street to Ulmerton



Road (Rte. 688). Turn right (west).


At Seminole Boulevard, turn left (south). Go south two miles to the traffic signal at 102nd Avenue. Turn right (west) and go to 113th Street.

On the southwest corner of 113th Street and 102nd Avenue, you'll see a SPC, Seminole Campus sign.

Turn left onto 113th Street, go about 1/4 mile and you'll come to a traffic signal that marks the entrance to the campus.

**- estimated time 17 min.
from 66th St. N. and Park Blvd.**

From South Pinellas County



From the intersection of 66th Street N and Park Boulevard, go west on Park Boulevard, passing the intersections of Belcher Road, Starkey Road and Seminole Boulevard.

At the next intersection (Seminole Mall will be on your right on the northeast corner) turn right (north) onto 113th Street.


Continue past the next traffic signal at 86th Avenue to the traffic signal at the entrance to the campus. Turn left (west) toward the campus.

**- estimated time 35 min. from Tampa
- estimated time 2 hr. from Orlando**

From Tampa & Orlando

Interstate 4 comes into Tampa from Orlando.

From I-4, take Interstate 275 S, bypassing downtown Tampa. I-275 becomes the Howard Frankland



Bridge heading west across Tampa Bay.


Once you cross the bay, take the Gandy Exit to Gandy Boulevard westbound

Gandy Boulevard becomes Park Boulevard after you cross U.S. 19. Continue on Park Boulevard until you reach 113th Street (about six miles).

Turn right (north) onto 113th Street.

Continue past the next traffic signal at 86th Avenue until you reach the next traffic signal at the entrance to the campus.

Turn left (west) onto the campus.




From Sarasota

- estimated time 1 hour, 17 min.

Head north on either US-41 or US-19 (41 joins 19). Go northwest toward Interstate 275 North, crossing the Sunshine Skyway Bridge over the mouth of Tampa Bay. Take I-275 North all the way up to Exit 15, State Road 694 (Gandy Boulevard), and at the bottom of the exit road, turn left onto Gandy/Park, going west toward Pinellas Park and then Seminole.

Pass the intersections of 49th Street North, Belcher, Starkey/Park St., and Seminole Blvd. At the next intersection (Seminole Mall on your right - northeast corner) turn right (north) on to 113th Street. Continue past the next light at 86th Avenue, to the light at the entrance to the campus. Turn left (west) toward the



campus.

The City Recreation Ctr. and Seminole Community Library @ SPC Seminole are also on the left side of the road; and the Post Office is on your right.


From New Port Richey

- estimated time 59 minutes

Start heading south on US-19 S. Exit right at Largo (Rte. 686), turning right (west) on East Bay Drive. Continue west past the large intersections of Belcher and Starkey/Missouri. Turn left (south) onto Clearwater/Largo Road (which turns into 113th Street).

Go south, passing the traffic light at 102nd Avenue. On the right side (southwest corner) of 102nd you'll see the SPC Seminole Campus sign. Continue south on 113th, about 1/2 mile and you come to a set of lights that mark the entrance to the campus.

The City Recreation Ctr. and Seminole Community Library @ SPC Seminole are also on the right side of the road; and the Post Office is on your left.




From Gainesville

- estimated time 2 hours 39 minutes

Take the I-75 South towards Tampa, then merge onto I-275 towards Tampa/St Petersburg.

I-275 becomes Howard Frankland Bridge, heading west across Tampa Bay. Once across the bay, take Exit 31B on to Ulmerton Road (Rte. 688) and continue west until you get to 113th Street/Ridge Road.



Turn left (south) onto 113th Street. Go south 2 miles to the traffic light at 102nd Avenue. On the right side (southwest corner) of 102nd you'll see the SPC Seminole Campus sign. Continue south on 113th, about 1/2 mile and you come to a set of lights that mark the entrance to the campus.
