Affordable Housing Opportunities

Affordable Rental Units

Pinellas County provides funding to build and revitalize multi-family units for the county's diverse needs. Special emphasis is placed on creating energy efficient units to reduce monthly maintenance costs and reduce environmental impacts.

Home Improvement Loans

A low interest loan program is available to income-qualified homeowners who need assistance maintaining their homes and making needed upgrades. The program keeps neighborhoods looking their best, encourages energy efficiency and helps maintain property values. The program also assists with preparing homes for hurricane season by repairing or adding new roofs, windows and more.



Emergency Housing Assistance

Emergency assistance is available to eligible residents to help with rent, mortgage payments and utility bills through Pinellas County Health and Human Services.

Homeownership Opportunities

Pinellas County provides first mortgages to make the dream of homeownership a reality for qualifying families. The program also provides assistance with down payment and closing costs.

Independent Living Grant

Pinellas County helps disabled homeowners remove physical barriers and add features that will make their homes easier to navigate. Improvements may include the addition of wheelchair ramps, grab bars in bathrooms, flashing lights for doorbells for the hearing impaired and other enhancements that remove a barrier to their disability.
