Joyner, chair of the Pinellas County Legislative Delegation, has announced that the Delegation will hold its second and final Public Hearing on Monday, December 14<sup>th</sup> in the City Council Chambers at Saint Petersburg City Hall located at 175 Fifth Street North in Saint Petersburg from 9:00 AM to 12noon to take final action on local bills which have been filed as well as speakers who will be seeking appropriations or general legislation. The public hearing will begin with local bills and concluding with speakers. "Given the continuing fiscal challenges our state is facing and our need to focus efforts on solutions to balance the state's budget, we will not be opening the Community Budget Issue Request System (CBIRS) this year. With the further decline in state revenues, it is my desire to avoid creating unrealistic funding expectations."

As a result of the President's decision, we will NOT be receiving or hearing any requests for appropriations and there will be no CBIRS requests filed this year. Please respect this notice and please do not come forward with money requests, accordingly.
