



PROJECT: Provides for Federal contribution toward the cost of a local shore restoration and protection project which involves placement of approximately 1,319,000 cubic yards of sand on the shore to provide a 60-foot width protective beach and the construction of groins at the south ends of Clearwater Beach Island, Sand Key, Treasure Island, and Long Key. The Federal participation authorized amounts to the portion of the first cost of the works applicable to the Federally owned shore on Sand Key plus one-third of the first costs applicable to other publicly owned portions of the shores of the islands. The total length of beach to be protected is 18.9 miles.
MEAN TIDAL RANGE: 1.5 feet.
