



Fertilizer Applicator License Requirement Information for Landscape Fertilizer Applicators in Pinellas County

Any person or company providing fertilizer application services within Pinellas County must display a Pinellas County vehicle decal. Complete the steps below to avoid violation of the Pinellas County Fertilizer Ordinance. For information visit: www.pinellascounty.org/fertilizer

- **STEP 1:** Complete a state-approved training course such as the *Green Industries Best Management Practices (GI-BMP)* from a University of Florida County Extension office. The course can be taken at the Pinellas County Extension classroom by registering online at www.uf-commhort.eventbrite.com. The course is also available as an online self-paced course or through ordering a DVD and completing the exam online through the GI-BMP Program website: <https://gibmp.ifas.ufl.edu>. Note: there are no Pesticide CEUs for the online course.
If you need assistance with registration, please call Pinellas County Extension at (727) 582-2100.
- **STEP 2:** Obtain the requisite Limited Fertilizer license from FDACS **by creating an account online and paying via credit card online to receive your fertilizer license within 24hours at** <https://aesecomm.freshfromflorida.com/>. Each applicator must have this license **regardless** of any other FDACS licenses held.
- **STEP 3:** Receive your vehicle decal by submitting a completed fertilizer affidavit to Pinellas County
