For your convenience, computers will be designated for participation at the following public libraries: Palm Harbor, Pinellas Park and St. Petersburg Branches (Main, North, South and West).

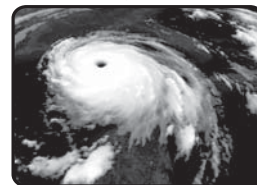
