

Agenda Item 4: Interlocal Agreements

Action Needed: Action

Background: The Homeless Policy Group approved, at its last meeting, the recommendation that the new Homeless Leadership Network be formally established by Interlocal agreements among the local governmental bodies, with invitations from them to other community groups.

Points of Consideration:

- Carl Brody, Pinellas County Attorney, has provided information for the Leadership Network about Interlocal agreements, and has provided copies of possible agreements. His memo is attached, Page 4-2.
- The first option for organization, a Section 163.01 Intergovernmental Organization, starts at Page 4-3.
- The second option, a Section 163.02 Council of Local Public Officials, starts at Page 4-12.
- Options 1 and 2 allow only elected officials to be full voting members of the Leadership Network.
- The 'Illustrative Inter-local Agreement' forwarded by Consultant Herb Marlowe, is at Page 4-15.
- Mr. Brody will be at the meeting to discuss the two options he has presented, as well as other ways to formalize the agreements among the members while allowing all of them to be full voting members.

Recommendation: Adoption of a structure of agreements and organization that allows all members to be full voting members.
