



Colors of Pinellas Employee Art Show: FAQs

Who will be judging the artwork?

The show will be judged by art professionals.

How many entries may I submit?

One or two entries.

Can one entry win two awards, such as First Place Adult Intermediate and Best of Show?

Entrants are normally limited to one cash prize. However, beginning in 2016, entrants may also receive, if selected by the judges, the Continuing Art Education Award (\$200 cash) as well as one of the other cash awards.

Can the same participant with two entries win more than one award in their classification, such as First and Second Place for Adult Intermediate?

No.

What are the size limits for artwork?

Regardless of whether the piece is a vertical or horizontal, all two-dimensional artwork should measure no more than 36" in any direction, including frame, nor weigh more than 40 pounds. Larger art pieces may be considered for entry with prior approval by Art Show Coordinators.

I have a quilt I would like to submit but it exceeds the 36" limit in any direction. Does this mean I can't enter this in the show?

Art pieces in the craft classification are not necessarily restricted to size or need be "framed". Depending on the piece, the manner in which it is displayed will be determined at the time of drop-off.

What are the specifications for the photo I must submit of my artwork?

Submit a high-resolution digital photograph for each art piece entered into the show. Each artist will receive a confirmation email instructing them how and where to submit these photographs.

My partner and I have lived together for many years. Is she eligible to enter the show?

Yes. Domestic partners are eligible to participate. No proof of a "formalized relationship" is needed.

Do I have to frame my artwork?

All art pieces to be hung must be framed or have hardware attached, such as wire and/or brackets.
