## WHAT IS A MEDICAL HOME?

A Medical Home is the place for you to receive primary, non-emergency health care, even after regular business hours. It is also a way to get some types of specialty care.

If you have a Medical Home, you do not have to wait hours in the emergency room for minor but painful problems like an earache or sore throat. You will learn how to take care of medical conditions such as diabetes at your Medical Home.

The professionals working in your Medical Home care about you.  
They want to help you live a healthier life.

## SERVICES PROVIDED

- Primary medical care, including lab work and necessary tests
- Wellness and prevention services, including annual physicals
- Prescriptions
- Cancer Screening
- Nutrition education and counseling
- Behavioral health screening and referral for treatment
- Case management services
- Referral for relief of dental pain
- Limited specialty care

## HOW DO I SIGN UP?

To be part of the Medical Home program, take these simple steps:

- 1) Select a convenient location. The locations are listed on the other side of this flyer.
- 2) Call to find out when your selected location is open.
- 3) Get your paperwork ready. See the list below.
- 4) Visit the selected location to apply.

## WHAT PAPERWORK SHOULD I BRING ON MY FIRST VISIT?

- Social Security Card
- Proof of ID (*Example: driver's license, state ID card, birth certificate*)
- Proof that you are a Pinellas County resident (*Example: rent receipt, utility bill, school or employment record, etc.*)
- Proof of legal citizenship, birth certificate, or immigration status if you were not born in the United States
- Proof of income for the past four weeks (*pay stubs; proof of child support/alimony; award letters from SSA; Veterans, Workers or Unemployment Comp.; proof of self-employment income; etc.*). *If you have no income you need to bring proof of how you are managing, such as a bank statement or a support statement from someone who is helping you.*



## DO I QUALIFY?

*To qualify for services you must:*

- ✓ be a Pinellas County resident between the ages of 18 and 64
- ✓ be uninsured and not eligible for other public assistance programs
- ✓ be a U.S. citizen or non-sponsored legal resident
- ✓ meet program income guidelines

If you qualify for the Pinellas County Health Program, medical services will be provided at the Medical Home close to where you live at no cost to you.
