

Social Action Funding Application Addendum

A few questions have been posed by potential applicants. This is an attempt to clarify those questions and to provide a “change in the application” update.

Changes

We are removing the minimum of \$10,000 and maximum of \$30,000 request amounts from the proposal; thus, they will not be considered fatal criteria. (The total amount of SAF available will remain at \$360,000.)

Clarification

- 1) Regarding Required Match or Leveraging – Required match must be from a federal, foundation, or state entity and verification must be provided. Leveraging of funds includes monetary or in-kind services and verification or supporting documentation must be provided.
- 2) Program Budget Summary on Page 12a, the third column title should read Projected FY 12/13.
- 3) Agencies applying for TBIN (1) time funding - licenses are \$550 per person for one year.
- 3) Homeless Initiative (HI) funding was not included in the FY 2012 award process as the Board of County Commissioners approved a one-time renewal option for FY 2011 HI recipients at the same award amount levels. Due to the agency closure of one of FY 2011’s grantees, the BCC has allocated the \$21,000 from that agency in the following manner:
 - \$10,000 to the Pinellas County Coalition for the Homeless (PCCH)/Homeless Leadership Network (HLN)
 - \$11,000 to 2-1-1 Tampa Bay Cares, Inc. to purchase additional Tampa Bay Information Network (TBIN) licenses.
