



Medical Care... on Wheels

Services are Available for Homeless Individuals and Families



The Mobile Medical Unit is a medical office on wheels that provides primary health care at no charge to eligible homeless patients with incomes at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level. A sliding scale fee for service is applied for incomes between 101 - 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Emergency services are not provided on the unit. The unit travels to locations in Pinellas County serving homeless residents who have no insurance.

The **Mobile Medical Unit** offers:

- Primary medical care, including lab work and necessary tests
- Wellness and prevention services, including annual physicals
- Prescriptions
- Cancer screening
- Nutrition education and counseling
- Behavioral health screening and referral for treatment
- Case management services
- Referral for relief of dental pain
- Specialty care
